Sub: - Hardship being faced by Industries in the state due to COVID 19 closure

Respected Sir,

Noida Entrepreneurs Association one of the oldest industrial Association in the area representing about 10 thousand industries Noida, Greater Noida and surrounding areas. All the entrepreneurs are devoted and law abiding citizens of India are fully committed to Hon'ble Prime Minister and Our Chief Minister Yogi Ji to fight the CORONA Pandemic together with all our might.

We have paid the salary of March 2020 to our labour and staff accepting the dictates of the Government though we are already relenting under the slow down and adverse economic conditions prevailing all over the world for past so many months.

We humbly state that Government has taken care of all sections of society i.e. labour by way of providing wages, weaker sections by way of PM relief fund and free rations, free rent, free fees, and mandatory salary from industries. Farmers have been granted funds by way of Pradhan Mantri Mann dey scheme and many other schemes but nothing for the industries which are already suffering due to weak economic conditions, word over financial crises and now this corona pandemic.

All our business operations are closed down and we do not have any funds at all. The raw material and finished good lying in our factories at the time of lock out has deteriorated or of no use. Our business dues are not being realized and we have to pay all utilities and other Govt. corona dues. It would be very difficult for us to restart the business operations once the lock down is withdrawn due to paucity of funds and other resources.

We earnestly request you to come to the rescue of the Industries and save us from untimely death by –


1. Paying the lock down period salary from the huge funds reserves of ESIC which is basically formed for the purpose of providing for **medical and accidental emergencies** and this lock down is such emergency only. By paying for this period ESIC is saving huge cost towards medical contingencies due to corona virus would have arisen if lock down would not have been there.
2. Withdraw all utilities bills as Power, Water, lease rent and other dues for this lock down period and instruct all local bodies to way of all charges till 30th June 2020.
3. Defer all bank EMIs without interest due for at least 3 months as coming back to normal status for a closed down unit will take minimum 3 month's time.
4. Provide additional financial support in form of increase working capital limits with reduce interest at the most 6% enabling us to compete internationally to fill up void created by COVID-19 pandemic.
5. Release all due payments of Govt supplies, GST refund, subsidies and all so that cash flow may stabilise.
6. All the industrial units may be allow to run and transportation of material may be permitted without any restriction while maintaining full social distancing norms so that industry may come out of the deep trench. This may facilitate survival of industry to some extant.

Sir, we most respectfully submit that in case we do not get these reliefs **and if we have to bear salary, wages and other expenses for April lock down period than we shall not have any option but to close down** our operations and many of us may even go out of business for or face insolvency.

Therefore we request for an early action in the matter before it turns out another epidemic.
